Dear Parents and Carers.

It may be cold, but this week we have had glorious weather. In school, there have been a wide range of activities and opportunities to engage the pupils throughout the week, which they have thoroughly enjoyed.

Year 2: This week, the pupils have started to learn 2 songs by The Beatles, which they will be performing in February as part of Infantasia. This is a chance for schools within Sunderland to come together and enjoy the love of singing. Even after only a handful of practises, they sound amazing, and I hope that they have been singing around the house. I know that I've had the songs in my head as I've been working in school.

Chinese New Year: Around school this week, lots of classes celebrated the year of the rabbit - from activities in reception to a Chinese restaurant in the Treehouse. On Thursday, our kitchen staff created some excellent Chinese dishes to help celebrate the New Year. All the children who I spoke to after they had eaten described the food as delicious.

Reminder: As we come to the end of the second week back, can I please remind everyone of a few expectations we have in school.

- Please make sure there is only water in their drinks bottle during the day.
- We encourage the children to enjoy a healthy snack for their break fruit etc. not chocolate or crisps.
- Pupils can wear a watch to school, however, no other jewellery should be worn. If any children have their
 ears pierced, they should only wear stud earrings until the time period where the hole could close up has
 passed.
- A number of pupils probably received make-up as part of their Christmas presents. While this is a lovely gift, make-up should not be applied for school.

Car Parking Reminder: If you are unable to walk to school, can I remind all adults who use a car to be sensible and considerate towards the residents from all streets surrounding the school when parking during the morning and afternoon. Please also don't park in front of the school gates or on the path/grassed area - both of which have been noticed this week by staff - as this could lead to an accident amongst our JFK family. Please use the laybys along the main road or use the carparks behind the school or at the Westwood Club. Thank you for your support in making our school a safer place.

Drop Off and Collection: Just a reminder that the school doors open at 8.40am so that all children can enter the building before registration at 8.50am. The gates will be closed after this time, so any children arriving after 8.50am should enter school through the main entrance and will be marked as late

Pupil Absence: Just a reminder that if your child is unable to attend school, then you do need to contact the school office to let us know. Even if you get the answer phone, please leave a message, as Mrs Mackintosh and Mrs Watson do listen to these throughout the morning. As a school, we have a duty of care, and this includes being accountable for all children every day.
